Dear Keystone Educational Collaborative families:

Keystone Educational Collaborative will participate in a Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) Program Review during the week of March 7, 2022. The Department is required by federal and state special education law to conduct periodic reviews of collaborative programs throughout the Commonwealth. Program Reviews, such as the one being conducted at Keystone, will include document review, student record review, observations of the facility including instructional areas, and interviews of staff.

A detailed report for the program will describe the implementation status of each requirement reviewed by DESE. Where program standards are found not to be fully implemented, the school must implement the corrective actions ordered by DESE to bring those areas into compliance with the respective statutes or regulations. Collaboratives are encouraged to incorporate the corrective action activities into their improvement plans, including their professional development plan. The report will also note those program standards which the team found substantially implemented, and revised standards for which implementation is in progress. Both the Department's report and the program's response to DESE are public information and will be available to the public upon request.
